

## TUITION AND FEES

Students taking Dual Enrollment courses on MTC campuses are responsible for the cost of tuition and books. However, they may be eligible for SC Lottery Tuition Assistance Program (LTAP), and South Carolina Workforce & Industrial Needs Scholarship (SC WINS) funding. Students will be responsible for tuition and fees not covered by these aid programs. The cost of Dual Enrollment courses on high school campuses is coordinated between the college and the school district. Students should check with their high school for course options and costs.

Students must complete the South Carolina Lottery Tuition Assistance Program form and take at least six college credit hours to receive assistance. The form can be found at [MIDLANDSTECH.EDU/admissions/forms](https://midlandstech.edu/admissions/forms).

Upon successful course placement, Dual Enrollment students may take any course MTC offers, with selected options for classes taken on a high school campus. Some of the subjects include:

**Fine Arts:** music | art | theatre

**Humanities:** composition | literature | public speaking | philosophy | religion | foreign languages


**Social and Behavioral Sciences:** psychology | sociology | history | criminal justice



## HOW TO ENROLL IN DUAL ENROLLMENT

It only takes a few simple steps to enroll in the Dual Enrollment program and kick-start your college career.

- 1 Talk to your high school counselor about enrolling in one of MTC's Dual Enrollment options. (Don't forget to get your parent or guardian's permission, too!)
- 2 Apply to MTC by filling out the application found at [MIDLANDSTECH.EDU/dualenrollment](https://midlandstech.edu/dualenrollment).
- 3 Return the completed application to [dualenrollment@midlandstech.edu](mailto:dualenrollment@midlandstech.edu) or call 803.738.7178 for our mailing address information.
- 4 Once accepted to MTC, our team will work with you on an assessment packet you'll need to complete to determine course placement. We'll get in touch once your application is complete about the placement testing requirements.\*
