

If any of the following items seem to apply to any child that you know, please call your local school district to discuss your concerns.

- \Box Has difficulty turning over.
- \square Has difficulty sitting-up alone.
- \Box Has difficulty crawling.
- \Box Often bumps into objects.
- \Box Does not respond to affection.
- \Box Does not talk.
- \Box Has limited vocabulary.
- \Box Cannot ride a tricycle or pedal toy.
- $\hfill\square$ Cannot feed self.
- \Box Does not assist in dressing.
- $\hfill\square$ Does not respond to own name.
- \Box Does not say words clearly.
- $\hfill\square$ Does not play well with others.
- $\hfill\square$ Has poor balance or coordination.
- $\hfill\square$ Cannot name family members.
- \Box Cannot put toys/materials away.
- $\hfill\square$ Does not follow simple commands.
